Span tag in HTML

In HTML, the tag is used to group inline-elements in a document. It doesn't inherently represent anything specific semantically, nor does it affect the layout directly. However, is quite useful for styling purposes with CSS or manipulating elements with JavaScript because it allows you to target inline elements or segments of text without introducing any additional formatting or structure.

- The div tag is known as the Division tag. The div tag is used in HTML to make divisions of content on the web page like (text, images, header, footer, navigation bar, etc).
- Div tag has both opening(<div>) and closing (</div>) tags and it is mandatory to close the tag.
- The <div> tag is a fundamental HTML element used to structure and group larger blocks of content or layout parts on a web page.
- Unlike the tag, which is used for inline grouping and styling, <div> is a block-level element and naturally takes up the full width available, starting on a new line before and after the element.

The **<aside>** tag in HTML is a semantic element used to mark up portions of a page that could be considered separate from the main content. These sections are often related to the surrounding content but serve a secondary role, such as providing additional information, contextual ads, sidebars, or callouts. The content inside an **<aside>** element should be indirectly related to the main content, making it suitable for tangents or supplementary information.

HTML <section> Tag

The HTML <section> tag is used to define a section in a document. This tag is part of HTML5's grouping content elements and is intended to group thematic content blocks within a document. The <section> tag can be useful for organizing content into logically grouped areas that make sense when read independently from the rest of the page.

Examples of <section> Usage

- A chapter in a book
- A group of related articles in a magazine or newspaper
- Different sections of a single-page application
- Parts of a blog or news site articles, such as the comment section or the navigation links that group related items
